The exotic grape of Croatia called Crljenak Kaštelanski is California's Zinfandel. Very available in the 1850's, many gold miners planted the grape. After 150 years, many vines are still producing in the Sierra Foothills. Zinfandel is very versatile. This example is produced in a stunning and pleasant Claret style. Won Gold at Orange County and Calaveras County wine competitions.

Charles B. Mitchell has been producing award-winning wines in the Sierra Foothills for over 20 years. In the early 2000s, he purchased the original UC Davis test plot and started to carefully tend our grapes to create some of the area's premier Zinfandels.
